FUNCTIONS:

In relation to Technology: the purpose is to assist the Board of Directors in the performance of its oversight responsibilities regarding the role of technology in the Entity's activities and business strategy, and specifically to:

1. Promote the technological advancement of the Entity in order to support the development of its business.
2. Encourage strategic reflection on new technologies and their impact on the business.
3. Monitor the strategic metrics established for management and control in the technological area, including the progress of developments and investments undertaken by the Entity in this field.
4. Review and report on technology-related plans and initiatives.
5. Assist the Board in the approval of the technology strategic plan.



6. Be informed of the annual IT systems plan.
7. Coordinate with the Joint Audit and Risk Committee in the oversight of technology and security risks and supervise the management of cybersecurity.
8. Issue prior reports on any matters within its remit that, where applicable, are to be decided by the Board of Directors, as provided for by law, the Articles of Association, or the regulations of the Company's corporate bodies.
9. Review, prior to their submission to the Board of Directors, the general policies of the Company or its Group which, by law or internal regulations, are required to be approved by the Board, within the scope of the Committee's responsibilities.

In relation to Quality:

10. Assist the Board in the supervision, evaluation and continuous improvement of service quality, as well as its impact on customer perception.
